Priority 1 What you said: Farman Street – Anti social behaviour in the area of Farman Street.

What we did: We plan to speak with the licensed premises in the surrounding area regarding noise issues, smoking areas for their customers, and encouraging residents to report incidents directly too us.

Priority 2 What you said: Waterloo Street Communal Gardens – Anti social behaviour and thefts of plants.

What we did: We will liaise directly with the residents of Waterloo Street and encourage all incidents to be reported. We will also increase our patrols in this area.

Priority 3 What you said: The area(s) of John Street and Second Avenue – Anti social behaviour and increased noise from licensed premises.

What we did: We plan to visit the licensed premises in this area to discuss this issue. We will also increase our patrols to this area especially during the evenings.
