Priority 1 What you said: Dog Fouling- Waterloo Street

What we did: We held an action day with the dog wardens and park rangers from Brighton and Hove council.

What happened: One member of public was spoken too regarding this issue.

Priority 2 What you said: Waterloo Street – Traffic travelling the wrong way up Waterloo Street travelling into Brunswick Street East.

What we did: We held an action day on Waterloo Street targeting vehicles travelling the wrong way. Although no vehicles were stopped travelling the wrong way, five tickets were issued for out of date tax on vehicles in the surrounding area. We will also visit businesses in the local area, delivering leaflet information advising that Waterloo Street is one way.

What happened: We will review results of our action day during our local action team meeting.

Priority 3 What you said: Brunswick Square – young people and students gathering late evenings.

What we did: We have visited schools and language schools in our local area to advise them of the issues in Brunswick Square of young people gathering. We will also increase our patrols of the area.

What happened: All results will be discussed at our next local action team meeting.
